




## Analysis of Skeg Extension of Flow and Turbulence





#### **PURPOSE:**

To present for approval the following proposed operating schedules:

- 2026 Winter and Spring Operating Schedules for the Nantucket route; and
- 2026 Winter and Spring Operating Schedules for the Martha's Vineyard route.

#### **BACKGROUND**:

This past April, the Authority placed newspaper advertisements of its proposed 2026 Winter, Spring, Summer and Fall Operating Schedules for both its Martha's Vineyard and Nantucket routes for the period from January 5, 2026, through January 5, 2027. <sup>1</sup> Notices of the proposed schedules were also published for public comment on the Authority's website.

On May 15<sup>th</sup>, the Authority received a petition with respect to its proposed schedules that the residents of the Town of Falmouth and surrounding areas signed. In their petition, the 250 residents (2 signatures were duplicates) objected to the Authority's scheduling of a 5:30 a.m. freight trip from Woods Hole. They requested that the Authority cancel the approval of a 5:30 a.m. freight trip from Woods Hole. As has been the situation in the past, the petitioners objected to large trucks traveling to that 5:30 a.m. ferry because they wake up Falmouth residents beginning at 5:00 a.m. and earlier. This year, they are also objecting to the Vineyard's 5:30 a.m. departure, stating the same reasons for the Woods Hole departure. The petitioners did not object to cars traveling on that ferry.

On May 28, 2025, the Authority conducted a public hearing on the proposed 2026 schedules. There were no comments received at or following the hearing regarding the proposed 2026 Winter, Spring, Summer, and Fall Operating Schedules for the Authority's Nantucket route. Instead, all comments received at the hearing and in writing before and after the hearing have been

The Authority's Enabling Act requires the Authority to post and advertise in newspapers with general circulation in Falmouth, Barnstable, Martha's Vineyard, Nantucket and New Bedford all of its proposed schedule changes at least 60 days prior to their effective date.

directed at Martha's Vineyard's increasing freight traffic that travels to and from the Authority's Woods Hole terminal. In particular, the trucks traveling on the ferry that leaves Woods Hole for Martha's Vineyard at 5:30 a.m. during the Authority's summer operating schedules, as well as the large trucks that utilize the 5:30 a.m departure from Vineyard Haven. <sup>2</sup>

Because there were no public comments directed to any of the Authority's proposed 2026 schedules for the Nantucket route, management recommends the approval of the 2026 Winter and Spring Operating Schedules for the Nantucket route. In sum, the proposed winter and spring operating schedules for the Nantucket route would start on January 5, 2026, one day later as in 2025, and run through May 13, 2026, ending one day later than this year. In addition, the 2026 Nantucket operating schedules would be essentially the same as the ones approved for 2025, with the exception of triple crewing the freight boats during the spring schedule.

The proposed 2026 Winter and Spring Operating Schedule for the Martha's Vineyard route, which would run from January 5, 2026 through May 13, 2026, would start one day later and end one day later than in 2025. Again, the Martha's Vineyard route would see no changes to the trip times, quantity of trips, or vessel crewing during this schedule. Management recommends the approval of the 2026 Winter and Spring Operating Schedules for the Martha's Vineyard route. It should be noted that dependent on construction in Vineyard Haven, the Authority may add or take away the 5:30 a.m. departure.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Members vote to approve the 2026 Winter and Spring Operating Schedules for the Nantucket route, and the 2026 Winter and Spring Operating Schedules for the Martha's Vineyard route, as proposed.

#### **PURPOSE**:

To request approval from the Members to authorize the General Manager to purchase two (2) 40-foot low floor electric transit buses from the lowest responsible vendor.

#### **BACKGROUND**:

Staff is seeking to continuing the bus replacement program with additional electric buses. The Authority will be looking to join a state contract as well as identify Grant money to help with the purchase of these new buses. Currently staff is estimating the cost to not exceed \$2,500,000.00. This purchase will help continue our Green Initiative.

Currently, the Authority operates twenty-eight (28) buses and of those buses seven (7) are electric. We will continue to work on our replacement plan of two (2) buses a year, replacing them with electric or hybrid buses. It should also be noted that the Authority has purchased two (2) hybrid buses for the Hyannis route and delivery is expected shortly.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Authority members vote to authorize the General Manager to purchase two (2) 40-foot low floor electric transit buses from the lowest responsible vendor. This bid should not exceede \$2,900,000.000.

#### **PURPOSE**:

To approve the re-appointment of RSM US LLP as the Authority's independent auditors for the years ending December 31, 2025 & 2026.

#### **BACKGROUND**:

Attached please find a letter from RSM US LLP setting forth the scope of service to be provided and their proposed fee for the audit of 2025 activity. The proposed fee for fiscal year 2025 of \$160,000 includes both the annual audit, as well as a Circular No. A-133 Audit, and represents an increase of \$3,100 (the 2024 fee was \$156,900) compared to last year's fees.

The RSM US proposed audit plan for 2025 would be similar to the 2024 scope of services and would include an in-depth review of the Authority's general computer controls and procedures. The general scope of services includes the complexities of the Governmental Accounting Standards Board pronouncements related to pension liabilities as well as other postemployment benefits (OPEB).

Thirteen years ago, the Authority issued a Request for Proposals for Auditing Services and RSM was the consensus top ranked proponent for non-price criteria and for the overall proposal. While RSM has audited the Authority's activities these past thirteen years, the firm has a personnel rotation policy that provides the highest level of client services with the least amount of disruption to the Authority. In addition, the periodic rotation of personnel along with the review of audit findings by a concurring partner within the firm provides the Authority with a change in perspective without the need to change audit firms. In addition, RSM is subject to peer review on an ongoing basis.

It should be noted that Non-Federal entities that expend \$750,000 or more in a year in Federal awards are required to have a single or program-specific audit conducted for that year in accordance with the provisions of the U.S. Office of Management and Budget ("OMB") Compliance Supplement and the provisions of the Single Audit Act; Subpart F of Title 2 U.S. CFR Part 200, "Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards". The Federal grants awarded to the Steamship Authority are expected to exceed this threshold for all three years of the proposed

agreement. This additional audit requirement has been included in the scope of services required for this engagement.

RSM has submitted a price proposal for audit services that include the pricing with and without the single audit for 2025 and 2026. The price proposal for these services for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024 was \$156,900. Under the new two-year agreement, RSM has proposed for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2025 a total fee of \$160,000 and for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2026 a total fee of \$165,000 (or \$143,900 and \$148,500 if no single audit is required

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Members vote to reappoint RSM US, LLP as the Authority's independent auditors to provide a comprehensive financial audit and related services for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2025 for a total fee of \$160,000 and for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2026 for a total fee of \$165,000 (or \$143,900 and \$148,500 if no single audits is required).
